## **Exams April – June 2024**

### **External Exams: iGCSE & A Level**

The external exams begin on Friday 26th April. Following the Easter break, all students are expected to attend school as normal during the weeks of Monday 15th & 22nd April.

Study Leave will begin for Years 11 & 13 on Monday 29th April. We will be conducting revision sessions during timetabled lessons throughout the exam period and a schedule of topics will be provided for all students to choose lessons they would like to attend in support of their revision. However, there will be a requirement for some students to attend sessions in subjects where continued support is necessary to ensure successful progress. We will send a letter home on Friday 19th April detailing whether or not your child is required to be in school during Study Leave, and for which subjects.

Yr10 students who are sitting an early-entry IGCSE exam this summer are expected in school as normal throughout the examination period.

We advise all students taking external exams this year to use the upcoming break in a planned and purposeful way to maximise their potential for success. This includes revising subject content, practising with past papers and exam style questions, as well as enjoying some well-deserved break to refresh and replenish in advance of the exam season.

### **Internal Exams**

Internal assessment for Years 10 & 12 will take place during the week of Monday 13th – Friday 17th May. These exams are vital for assessing students' current progress and allow us to devise interventions in anticipation of next summer's IGCSE and A Level series.

In keeping with their project-based curriculums, Year 9 will be set lesson-based end of year assessments.

**Reports:**

In anticipation of the PTS Conferences, Year 9 reports will be published to the parent and student portals this afternoon. Please look out for an email from our IT administrator on how to access these reports.

Year 10 – 13 reports will be published at the end of term, in preparation for all summer exams.

**Language IGCSE Speaking Exam**

The Language Department will commence our IGCSE Speaking Exam next week for Year 11 students. This examination fulfils one of the exam components, namely Component 3. The process begins with students preparing in the waiting room for 10 minutes before the exam starts. Each speaking exam session will last around 10-13 minutes per candidate and will require them to respond to one role-play scenario and engage in two topic-based conversations. We are dedicated to preparing these students for the exam and hope to receive support from parents as well. Students are required to bring their ID cards and ensure punctuality on the day of the exam.

The iGCSE Speaking is scheduled to take place on Monday (18th March 2024) for Chinese and Friday (22nd March 2024) for Spanish.
